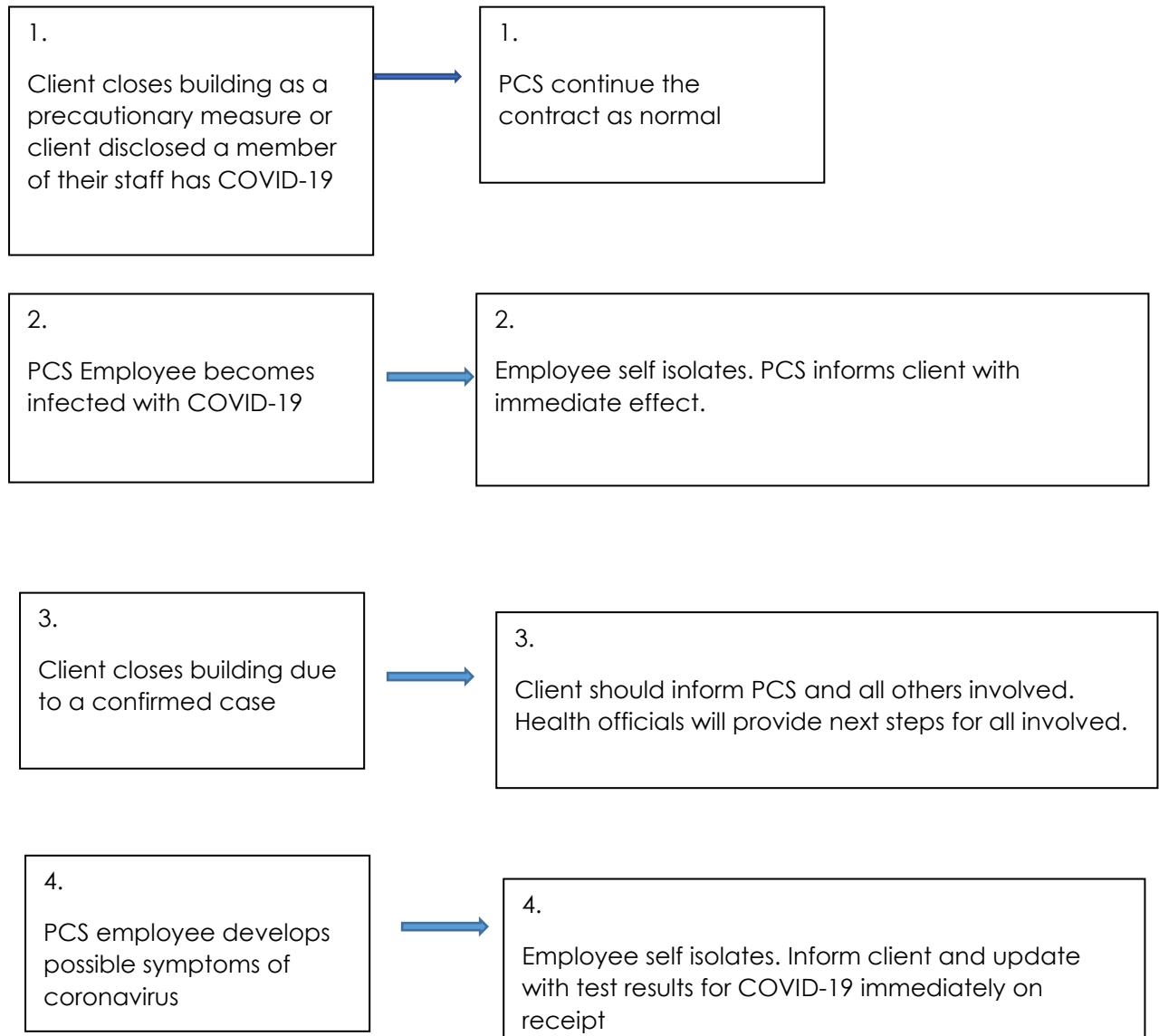


## Coronavirus Policy

### Viral prevention cleaning methods

Although we cannot assist with de-contamination of workplaces in the event of a positive test result, we can assist our clients with prevention methods as an addition to current cleaning schedules. This can include:

- Provision of hand soap and anti-bacterial sanitisers throughout the workplace.
- Increased cleaning and disinfectant of high touch areas such as doorknobs, handles, counters, appliances, telephones and bathrooms etc.
- Deep cleans and sanitisation of workplaces.

### How to stop the spread of Coronavirus

There is no vaccine for coronavirus so to help prevent a coronavirus infection, do the same things you do to avoid the common cold:

- Wash your hands thoroughly and often for at least 20 seconds. Use hand sanitiser if soap and water are not available
- Wash hands regularly after using public transport
- put used tissues in the bin immediately
- Cover your nose and mouth with a disposable tissue when you cough or sneeze or do so into your elbow to stop the germs going airborne
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands
- Keep your hands and fingers away from your eyes, nose, and mouth
- Avoid close contact with people who are infected or sick
- If you are worried about your symptoms, please call NHS 111. Do not go directly to your GP or any other healthcare environment

### Specialist cleaning of workplaces

Effective cleaning is vital where there are suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19.

Cleaning and disinfecting of areas where contact has been made should only be performed by staff trained in the use of the appropriate PPE required for the task. PCS can carry out specialised cleaning in line with GOV.Uk COVID-19 guidance.
