To address this issue, PCS are now offering eco-friendly cleaning products that are made from natural, renewable resources, with the added benefit of being biodegradable. Aqueous Ozone System

Since the pandemic we have had many opportunities to use our Aqueous Ozone System, to great effect. This system is environmentally sustainable, which almost completely eradicates the use of chemical products used for cleaning.

Where can it be used?

It can be used anywhere you would normally use a cleaning solution. It is effective on glass, table tops, mirrors, and touch points as it is on walls, hard floors, and carpets. As it can be used in spray bottles, carpet cleaners, and floor scrubbers it is versatile for any environment.

CASE STUDY

The Primary First Trust

The Primary First Trust celebrates and nurtures the diversity and distinctiveness of its partner schools. They are a growing network of 10 individual primaries across Bexley, Gravesham and Medway. All are at different points in their journey - each with a unique context, considerable strengths and specific opportunities.

8 schools in The Trust went to tender in early 2021, and we started our contract with them in April 2021. We provide cleaning services for them over 5 days a week during term time, covering general daily cleaning and lettings outside of school hours. Nonterm time cleaning is provided by a pre-planned roster of compressed hours. We successfully started the contract with a smooth TUPE process. Operatives were guided through every stage of the transfer, to ensure full relay of information, and to distil confidence. We ensure our operatives are provided with all the information necessary to make informed decisions regarding the transfer of employment during this time. Members of our senior management team are always on hand to respond to calls or emails the operatives may have regarding contracts of pensions.


THE **PRIMARY** FIRST TRUST

The operatives we supply to the schools include a mix of day cleaners, evening cleaners, and weekend cleaners. We have been able to provide specialist cleaning to areas in need to greater care– such as hall floors. The Contract Manager who oversees all sites is well versed in maintaining communication and order between the schools. Bringing operatives together to provide additional hours when one school has reduced numbers due to sickness. Or sharing resources in the event of an emergency. The Contract Manager has successfully brought all schools together to work in harmony and has created a sense of team across all sites.

We introduced our Aroma Care range of cleaning products to these sites. They use abio-enzyme to produce a thorough clean without the use of harsh chemicals. This range has a low carbon footprint, comes in recyclable or reusable containers, and is certifies as pet safe. We have used these products in a number of our schools to great effect, including special needs schools, and have always received positive feedback.
